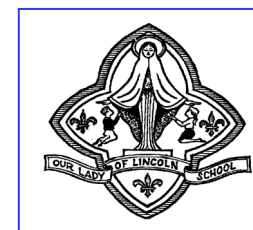

### Maths

Maths will focus on:

- Multiplication and Division
- Measurement (Length/Perimeter)
- Fractions
- Decimals

We will also have a continuous focus on Times Tables in preparation for the national tests taken In June



### English

This term we will be learning about biographies. Children will learn about the related features and apply them to their own writing.

After half term, we will learn about the features of mystery stories as we read 'The Highland Falcon Thief' an exciting mystery set on board a train!



### History

We will learn about life in Saxon England and different aspects of Viking life while considering how England changed during this conflict.

Children will develop their Historical skills by learning to critically evaluate sources of evidence and consider different perspectives of events.



### Science

In Chemistry, children will be learning about the different states of matter, solids, liquids and gases. They will explore and classify different materials while carrying out their own scientific investigations. After half term, Year 4 will carry out further investigations as they learn about human teeth and the digestive system as part of their Biology project.



### Other curriculum areas

As part of their learning children will also take part in French, Online Safety and RHE lessons throughout the term.

### Design and Technology

In DT, children will be making their own 'bag for life'. They will develop their design and evaluation skills, learn how to use a pattern, and apply finishing techniques to create a functional and aesthetically pleasing product.



### Music

Our next Music unit is all about Rock and Roll! Children will continue to develop their musical skills in evaluating, composing and performing music. They will also learn about key artists from the period including Elvis!



### P.E

This term the children will be taught by coaches from Premier Education. They will be learning Gymnastics and after half term, Hockey.
